
The European Water Framework

Irish Agriculture received EU support worth over €1.7 billion in 2020. In Wicklow, basic payments to farmers alone amounted to almost €27 million in 2019, with an average payment of €13,341 per recipient, which is the ninth largest in the country.

Many Member States including Ireland are witnessing increasing levels of local opposition to renewable energy projects, particularly for wind energy. Coillte (a state-owned company based in Newtownmountkennedy) is helping to come to grips with this dilemma, through a project supported by the Horizon 2020 programme.
