Irish Agriculture received EU support worth over €1.7 billion in 2020. In Monaghan, basic payments to farmers alone amounted to over €27 million in 2019, with an average payment of €7k per recipient.


The EU Leader programme has supported communities, businesses and farming enterprises for years. Take a look at how Leader funding has supported Monaghan in recent years.
