Irish Agriculture received EU support worth over €1.7 billion in 2020. In Limerick, basic payments to farmers alone amounted to almost €50 million in 2019, with an average payment of almost €10k per recipient.

An EU Leader-funded project, Shannon House Community Centre in Castleconnell is an inspiring example of taking a disused, poor condition building in the heart of the village and creating "A Place for All" - the ethos of the local, voluntary ACM Community Group. Finishing touches are still underway for a full-scale opening in 2021.

### Saving the Hen Harrier

Limerick boasts two Special Protected Areas that are now havens for the Hen Harrier. The Slievefelim to Silvermines Mountains is an extensive upland site located in Counties Tipperary and Limerick. The Stack's to Mullaghareirk Mountains, West Limerick Hills and Mount Eagle Special Protected Area is another very large site centred on the borders between the counties of Cork, Kerry and Limerick.

Human error is estimated to play a role in 94 % of accidents, making failures or mistakes by drivers a major public safety concern. Intelligent systems that can monitor the driver's state and behaviour show promise in contributing to safety.
