Support for Wexford Farmers



Irish Agriculture received EU support worth over €1.7 billion in 2020. In Wexford, basic payments to farmers alone amounted to over €58.6 million in 2019, with an average payment of €14,015 per recipient, which is the firth largest in the country.

The Blackstairs Mountains are designated as a Special Area of Conservation because of the presence of European dry heaths and Northern Atlantic wet heaths. Regarded as seminatural, they require farming at a sustainable level to protect and preserve them.


